IT'S THE HURRICANE SEASON – REPORT SARGASSUM SEAWEED BUILD UP!

In recent years, we have seen an increasing amount of Sargassum seaweed around our islands and along our coasts, creating more hardship for fishers both on the coast and at sea.

Fisheries Early Warning and Emergency Response (FEWER) provides the LEK module to allow fishers to create and view daily fisher-generated reports of Sargassum build up in open waters and along the

- ✓ Reporting daily beach conditions
- ✓ Reporting daily movement of Sargassum in open waters
- ✓ Reporting dangers areas due to Sargassum build up



FEWER can help fishers to keep track of the Sargassum in the region.

FEWER and fishers' cell phones are companions to the VHF radio and GPS that together provide information and communications for safer fishing trips.
